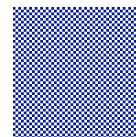

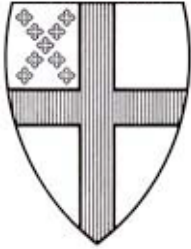

When and where?

The Kansas School of Ministry meets one weekend per month, from Fall through Spring, at Bethany Place Conference Center— 835 SW Polk, Topeka, KS.

Sessions begin at 6 PM on Friday night and conclude at noon on Sunday. Meals are catered. Tuition includes room and board, with the expectation that students will remain on site for the duration of each weekend.

Although the program is a two-year program, it is structured so that one may enter the program at the beginning of either year one or two.

Each weekend includes a total of ten contact hours of academic content and five contact hours of formation or PTE (Pastoral Theological Education).

PTE is a supervised small group opportunity to reflect and grow spiritually in the practice of faith and ministry.

Outside the weekend sessions students will have reading assignments, ministry projects, student sermons, papers to write, and verbatims. Access to the internet and e-mail is extremely valuable.
