#### **Things you should know about being a Happening Rector before applying:**

**(Please read this section completely.)**

1. The Happening Rector Selection Committee will interview Happening Rector Candidates during Summer Camp. If interview date is rescheduled, candidates will be notified by the Happening Coordinators

3. Being a Happening Rector will place a significant demand on your time.
4. There may be several meetings prior to your Happening that will require travel to meet with the Happening coordinator(s) and your co-rector(s).
