Things you should know about Peer Ministry before applying:

(Please read this section completely.)

Peer Ministry will be a total blast and very rewarding. However, it will require commitment on the part of those who want to participate. These are some things you should know before applying.

1. The first gathering of the Peer Ministers will be October 21-22, 2011. This retreat will include time for fun, getting to know each other and some preliminary peer ministry training. *It is crucial that all peer ministers attend this initial retreat. If you cannot come to the retreat on the 21st-22nd, please consider applying for the program next year instead.*
2. Because being a Peer Minister is a privilege. Peer Ministers strive to uphold a high moral standard, as they are to be examples for the rest of the youth.
3. Being a peer minister requires travel. You and your parents should be aware that driving to various corners of the Diocese is involved and in many cases expected.
4. Peer ministers are expected to be active members of their home parish and their youth groups.
5. Peer Ministers are expected to attend Diocesan Convention, both Peer Ministry Retreats, Summer Camp, and as many other Diocesan Youth Events as possible.
